### WEEK 1: Scripture says



### READ OUT LOUD FROM THE GOSPEL OF MATTHEW 4: 1 – 11

Jesus was led up by the Spirit into the wilderness to be tempted by the devil.

He fasted for forty days and forty nights, and afterwards he was famished.

The tempter came and said to him,

*'If you are the Son of God, command these stones to become loaves of bread.'*

But he answered,  
'It is written,

*"we do not live by bread alone,  
but by every word that comes from the mouth of God."*

Then the devil took him to the holy city and placed him on the pinnacle of the temple, saying to him,

*'If you are the Son of God, throw yourself down; for it is written, 'He has put his angels in charge of you.*

*They will catch you with their hands.  
And you will not hit your foot on a rock.'*
