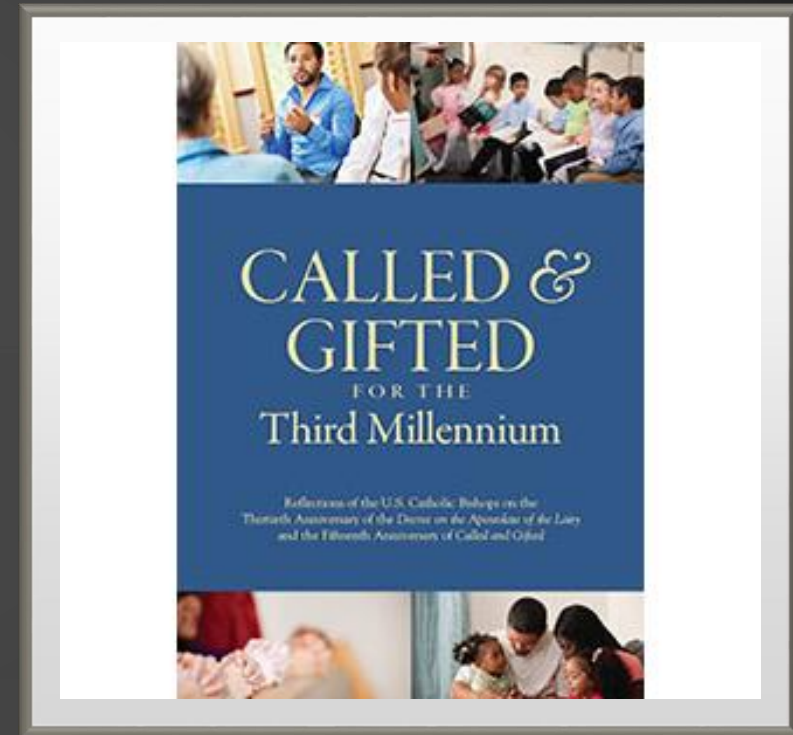

to another various kinds of tongues, to another the interpretation of tongues.*

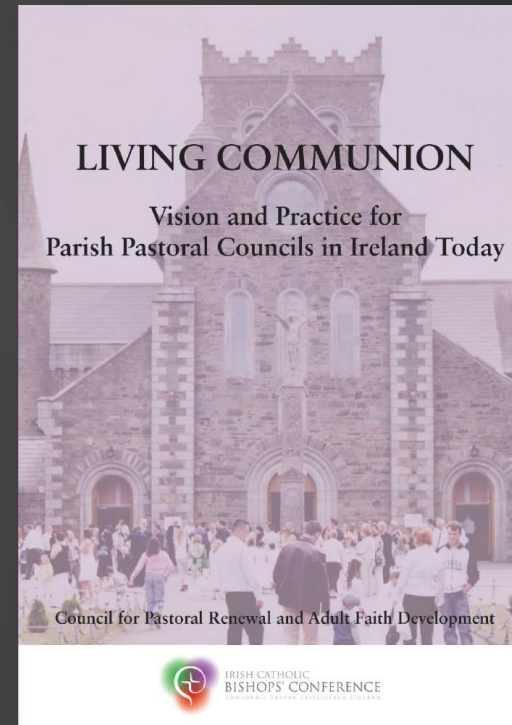
*All these are activated by one and the same Spirit,

- Laissez faire – it's up to you to get on with it
