AMEN.**

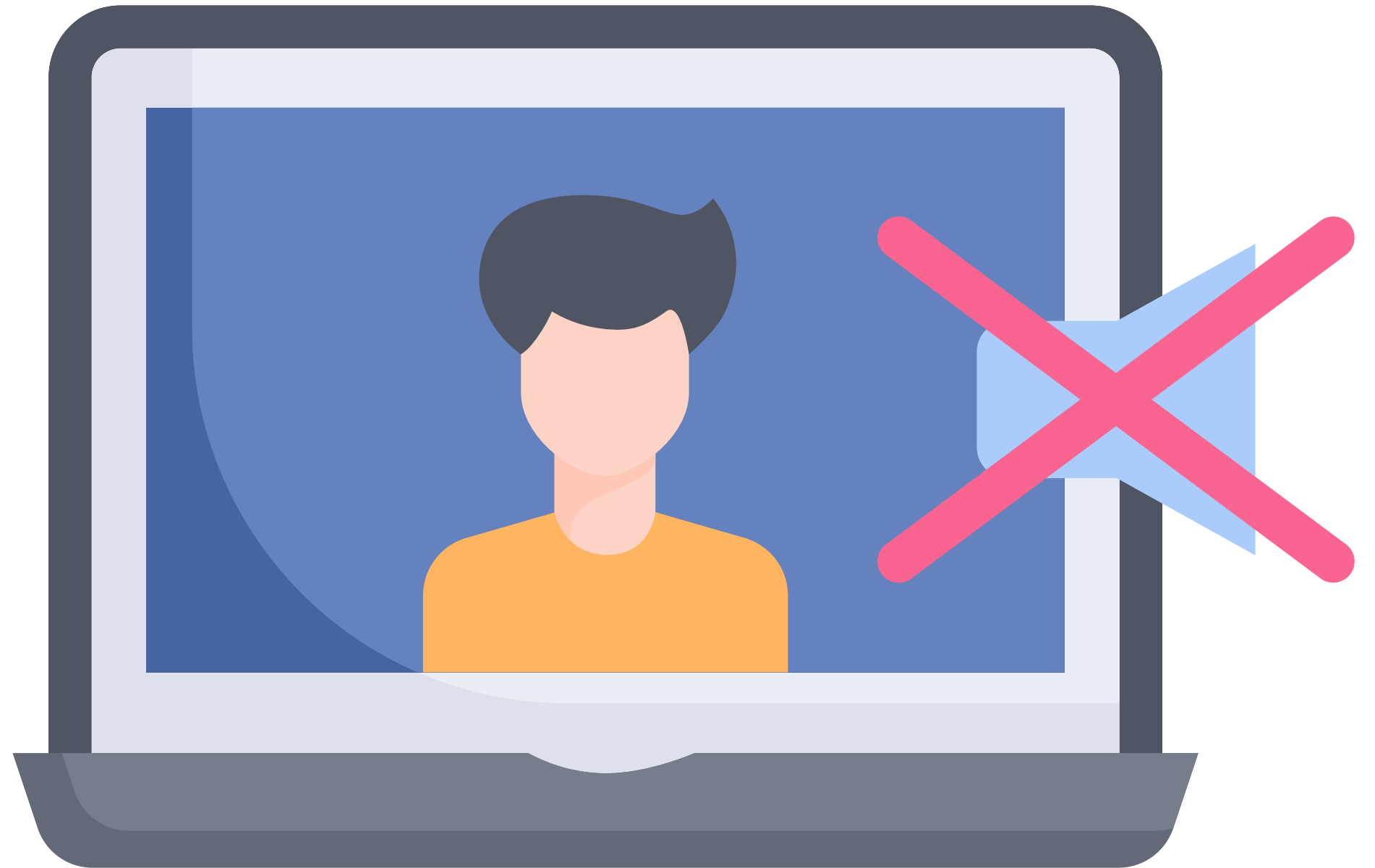
