





Youth & Young Adult Ministry

Building Hope through Music

There was a great atmosphere in Holy Trinity Church,
Donaghmede when six choirs/music groups from the Howth
Deanery gathered to sing together. They created a beautiful
warm sound supported by the Dublin Diocesan Music
Group. They learnt music from the **Laudate** and **Emmanuel**School Programmes and the Jubilee Year Hymn - *Pilgrims of*Hope. The singing was interspersed with instrumentals and
brief interviews as in Songs of Praise.



The networking that went on after the formal session was a real sign of hope.

Sharing resources came up and requests were made for assistance in various areas:

- There is a vacancy in Donaghmede for an accompanist for the Saturday Vigil Mass. Choir members who attended are very enthusiastic.
- St. Benedict's in Grange Park are looking for a Hymn Board to help the congregation find the relevant songs in the Music Book.
- The Music Director in Baldoyle has a collection of Baroque Recorders and would love to work with others for ensemble sessions. A beautiful instrument for a reflective time in the liturgy.
- The Seabury Choir in Yellow Walls Parish would enjoy the accompaniment of their beautiful organ for their liturgies. Anyone around who can help?

After Christmas, similar sessions will be offered to deaneries helping to build up parish resources and look at possibilities for cooperation in the various partnerships. This will help to build up a profile of the music resources of the diocese and establish a network of connections.

Blessing of New Abbot

Columba McCann OSB (above) received a special Abbatial Blessing from the Archbishop of Cashel and Emly, Kieran O'Reilly on 1 November at Glenstal Abbey. He was elected in September and took up office immediately. Before joining the Benedictines in 2004, Columba(John) contributed enormously to the celebration of liturgies in this Diocese as Master of Ceremonies. His gentle approach and scholarly wisdom created a solid foundation for liturgy throughout the Diocese. His musical compositions continue to enrich liturgies in Ireland and abroad. Abbot Columba is Chairperson of the Advisory Committee on Church Music, a national body. His organ playing continues to blossom and thrive. It was interesting to see him assisted by a M.C. rather than the other way around. May he continue to flourish.




